У даній добірці запропоновані авторські вправи для введення, автоматизації і закріплення лексики, яка вивчається у 5 класах.

Запропонована авторська добірка містить завдання з наступних тем: «Школа», «Родина», «Будинок». Кожна з поданих тем містить розділи для формування навичок письма та мовлення, а також для формування лексичних та граматичних навичок. Таким чином розроблені вправи допоможуть учням збільшити та вдосконалити необхідний лексичний запас 3 указаних тем. Їх можна використовувати як дидактичний матеріал при вивченні теми, а також як контрольні завдання.

Вправи даної збірки апробовані у п’ятих класах. Оскільки вправи розроблені 3 урахуванням вікових особливостей, вони легко сприймаються учнями, цікаві їм, сприяють швидкому та стійкому засвоєнню учнями навчального матеріалу. Крім того, завдання цієї збірки розширюють, порівняно з підручником, обсяг лексичних знань учнів.

Представлена система вправ дозволяє систематизувати знання учнів 3 англійської мови, формуючи основні мовленнєві навички. Ці види вправ дають плідний результат і посилюють зацікавленість учнів у вивченні англійської мови.
